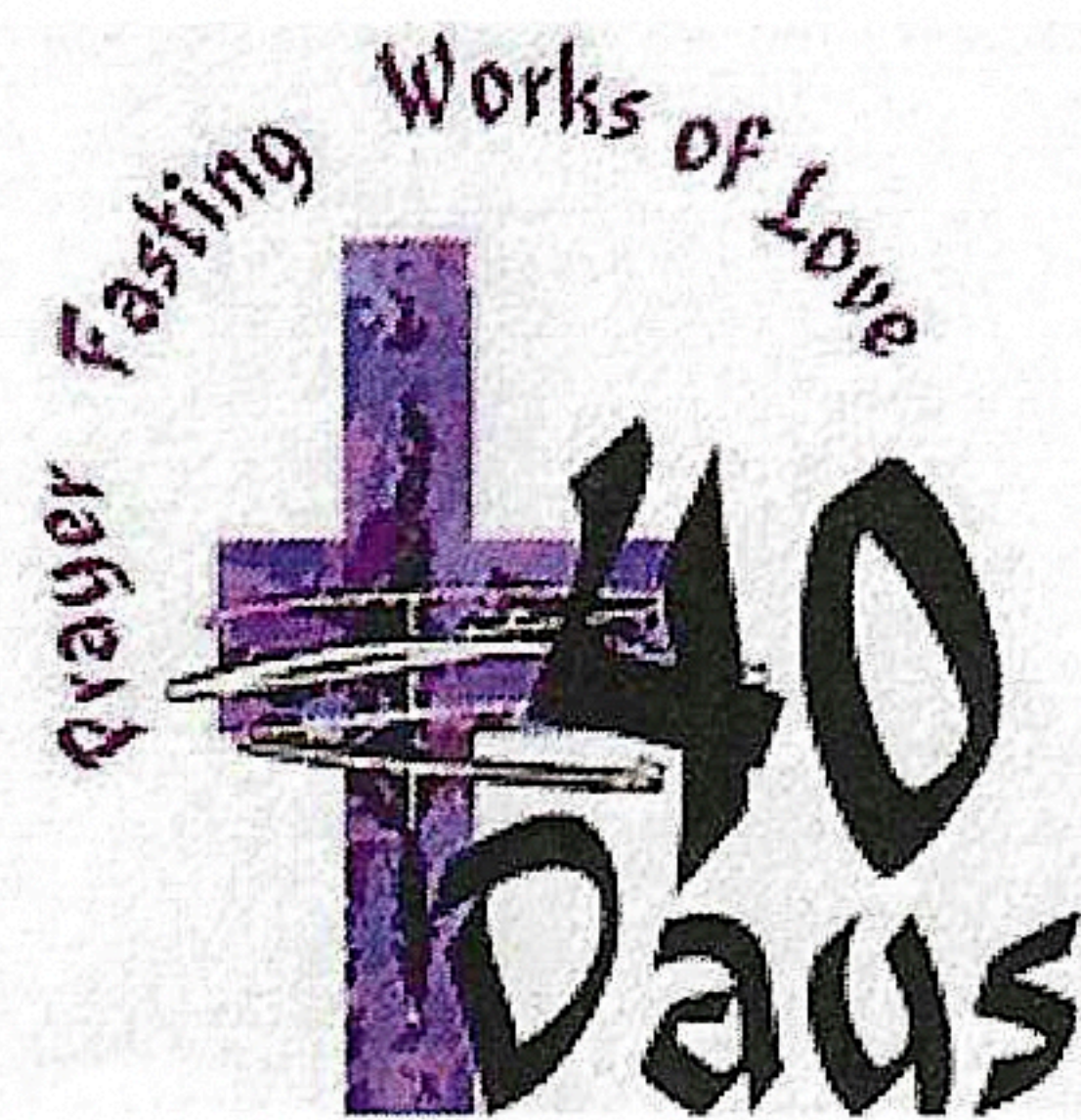


## *The Celebration of Lent*
