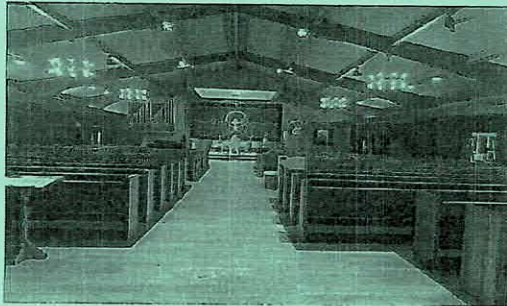

of advanced age or with serious illness.



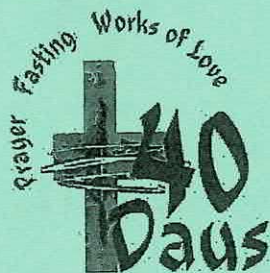
